

OSCEOLA TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 23-B:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 23-A

ORDINANCE NO. 23 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

BURNING ORDINANCE.

THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OSCEOLA ORDAINS:

1. This ordinance is adopted in the interest of public safety and is intended to promote the general peace, health, safety and welfare in Osceola Township by preventing foul odors caused by certain burning practices.

2. No person shall burn garbage, refuse, trash, yard waste, rubbish or similar material giving off foul odors in the outdoors, whether or not such materials are in a burn barrel, fire pit or other burning container.

3: This ordinance shall apply to the following areas of Osceola Township, Plat of the Village of Clark, Oak Acres, Pebble Beach, Aspen Acres, and Plat of Tamarack.

4. Any person, firm or corporation convicted of the violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed responsible for a municipal ordinance violation and shall be punished by a civil fine established pursuant to the following schedule:

1st violation w/in 3 year period*	\$50.00
2nd violation w/in 3 year period*	\$125.00
3rd violation w/in 3 year period*	\$250.00
4th violation w/in 3 year period*	\$400.00

*determined on the basis of the date of violation.

5. This Ordinance shall become effective the first day of January 2011.

PASSED and adopted by the Township Board, Township of Osceola, County of Houghton, State of Michigan, on the 10th day of November, 2010, and approved by me, as township Supervisor on the 10th day of November, 2010.
